Meals: **B L D** _See the **Tran Quoc Pagoda**, a 1,400 year old temple that features ten tiers enclosed by gardens, including a bodhi tree grown from a cutting of the original Buddhist tree under which Buddha sat. On **Hoan Kiem Lake** perched on the water is the **Tortoise Tower**.The Ngoc Son Temple, is on the lake with a narrow iconic red bridge. After lunch, in the Old Quarter Return to hotel

This evening, in the old Quarter, get ready to taste some of the local delights from stylish local Cafés with cocktails and delicious snacks. Arrive at a fascinating local joint, right on the railway tracks (literally!) to try infused rice wine and a Buffalo Jerky appetizer. The next foodie place is a lively local restaurant serving Bun Cha. A must taste Hanoi dish of noodles, pork and ,meatballs, with Nem (spring rolls)

Lastly, head out to try the local specialty of Pho Cuon, and learn the art of wrap 'n' roll, Vietnamese style.fresh & fragrant ingredients & Pho noodle

Jan 20 - Day 6. Hoi An Exploration & River Night Boat Trip

Meals: **B L D**

After breakfast, a half-day excursion to Cam Thanh village.

Experience traditional Fishing techniques and Crab catching.

Experience the Vietnamese bamboo basket boat ride, then head for a Vietnamese lunch. After lunch, explore the old town,- 200-year-old Tan Ky House: a beautiful home that has been preserved over seven generations.

-The 400 year Japanese Covered Bridge which for centuries connected the Chinese and Japanese towns. After the morning tour, return to the hotel.

Evening dinner by the Thu Bon River. After dinner, get on the wooden boat to take the night view. Light your flower lantern and drop it into the river. Lighting these lanterns is like a prayer to bring luck, peace, health, and good fortune. A beautiful sight as the flower lanterns go down the river. Jan 21, Day 7. Golden Bridge & Ba Na Hill – Fly to Saigon

Meals : **B L**

This morning a trip to Ba Na Hills. Once you reach the French-inspired hilltop resort *on a cable car* you will see the hills of Ba Na from a sea of clouds, and spot pockets of boulders and waterfalls. You will experience The French Village of L' Jardin - cobblestoned streets and Parisian-style architecture. Enjoy the rich terrains of **Truong Son** mountain that stretches to the South China Sea from the iconic Golden Bridge.

Lunch at **L'Etable Restaurant**

Just a few steps away from the village stands **the Linh Ung Pagoda**, home to the 27-meter high Buddha statue. See an impressive facade of traditional Vietnamese architecture when you visit the pagoda.

Next, head to **Loc Uyen Garden** and **Quan Am Pavilion** for a walk through well-manicured landscapes for some great pictures. **Nui Chua Peak** is the next high light before you fly from Da nang to Saigon.

Jan 22, Day 8. Cu Chi Tunnel & City Tour

Visit the **Cu Chi Tunnels**. The impressive underground systems developed by the guerrillas fighting in the Vietnam War. Explore some of the most important sights - **The Notre Dame Cathedral**, constructed by French colonists, is the largest cathedral in Southeast Asia. The Old Saigon Post Office, an architectural building one of the main attractions in the city. Visit the Reunification Palace, home of South Vietnam's President during the war. Overnight in Saigon

Jan 23, Day 9 Saigon - Mekong Delta Discovery

An excursion to **My Tho** to arrive at the Mekong delta. Board a Mekong cruise boat to **Thoi Son Island** to be entertained with traditional music. Enjoy a paddle boat cruise through the narrow canals and visit home grown industries like *coconut candy and rice-wine making*. Next, travel by motorized boat to another Mekong island to visit a bee farm and try tea with fresh honey from the beehives and enjoy fresh seasonal fruits. A visit to the **Vinh Trang pagoda** before returning to the hotel. A farewell dinner in **Hotel Des Art Saigon** Overnight in Saigon

Jan 24 - Day 10 Farewell from Ho Chi Minh City - Saigon – (SGN)

This morning, after breakfast - it is “farewell Vietnam” - you will be transferred to the airport for your flights back home, or for the extension trip to Cambodia.
